Have you been juggling with some of the techniques for advanced throwing? This weeklong boot camp will help increase your knowledge of throwing in a fun and interactive environment.

The camp is open to teens and adults who have experience throwing with clay and who can pull a 5-inch cylinder.

The registration fee includes the instruction fee, clay (25 lbs. per person), glazing and firing.

A tool kit and lidded bucket are needed for the camp.

Projects include: Mugs and bottles; non round forms; lidded forms, throwing off the hump; bowls; still life (3 pieces)
