Students will complete this beginner course with the knowledge necessary to continue throwing with pottery. At the end of this course, students may elect to continue with Open Studio or advance to the next class— Next Step Throwing.

- ◆ Preparing clay for throwing
- ◆ Centering and opening clay while throwing
- ◆ Pull walls and create basic cylinder
- ◆ Proper techniques and skills for trimming
- ◆ Basics of glazing completed projects
