This 6 week class is designed specifically to meet the needs of the person who knows basic throwing but wants to advance their skills.

Some of the skills taught will be:

- * Throwing shapes from a cylinder that have distinctive parts.
- * Throwing and fitting lids.
- * Making decorative designs on pots while throwing.
- * Pulling handles for different forms.
- * Throwing and working efficiently with handles and spouts.
- * Enhancing forms by attaching additional thrown parts

Students must have prior experience with basic throwing. Registration fee of \$80 covers all materials and supplies. Potters must have their own tool kits. Minimum 3; Maximum 8 will be accepted for class.
