3. **1504-1516 Williams Street; 401 Hampton Street; 9&21 Science Alley** (TMS# 09009-14-22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 31) Request for Certificate of Design Approval for new construction. *City Center Design/Development District*

Lucinda Statler, urban design planner, presented. The site is on the northeast corner of Williams and Hampton Street. The property has been rezoned to become part of the Canal Side Planned Unit Development (PUD). The language for that PUD was included as part of the Commission packet. This is a self-storage building.

Ryan Hyler recused from discussion and voting on this case.

David Tuttle of Land Holdings Two, the developer for the project, said numerous meetings were held with adjoining property owners, neighborhood associations, the Vista Guild, and staff to try and incorporate all comments and ideas, while still adhering to the guidelines.

Wes Taylor of LTC Associates, architect for the project, spoke on the design for the project.

Lucinda Statler, urban design planner, stated this project will present in May for site plan review. The landscape plan was included in Commission packets for review.

Motion by Mr. Savory to grant approval for the request for Certificate of Design for 1504-1516 Williams Street; 401 Hampton Street; 9&21 Science Alley.
