4. Quarterly reports to City Council: Gene Bell created a template that can be used to create consistent BPAC reports to council.
5. Community Outreach: There is currently an opportunity to collaborate with the City of Columbia's Climate Protection Action Campaign (CPAC) as they look for ways to increase points for their sustainability plan.
