

ORDINANCE NO.: 2005-121

*Repealing April 5, 1912 Ordinance to Palmetto Construction Company*

WHEREAS, on April 5, 1912, Columbia City Council adopted an Ordinance entitled "TO AUTHORIZE THE OCCUPATION AND USE BY THE PALMETTO CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, AS HEREIN SPECIFIED, OF THE SIDEWALK SPACE ADJOINING THEIR PROPOSED FIFTEEN STORY STEEL BUILDING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF MAIN AND WASHINGTON STREETS IN THE CITY OF COLUMBIA"; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that privileges granted unto Palmetto Construction Company by way of such ordinance are no longer in the best interests of the public; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia this 16th day of November, 2005 that the ordinance entitled "TO AUTHORIZE THE OCCUPATION AND USE BY THE PALMETTO CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, AS HEREIN SPECIFIED, OF THE SIDEWALK SPACE ADJOINING THEIR PROPOSED FIFTEEN STORY STEEL BUILDING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF MAIN AND WASHINGTON STREETS IN THE CITY OF COLUMBIA" adopted April 5, 1912 be and the same is hereby repealed.




