## Beginning Glaze Application (Instruction by Tim Graham)

Saturday, March 2, 2019 from 12-4 pm

This workshop will focus on application and use of cone 5 glazes. Basic application methods will be taught including dipping, pouring, trailing, brushing and spraying. Cone 5 glazes will be the focus. Class size limited to a maximum of 5 participants. **Registration fee:** \$40



## Plaster Press and Spring Molds—Three Day Workshop (Instruction by Angel Allen)

Tuesdays, March 5, 12 and 26 from 6-8 pm

Learn how to make and use plaster press and spring molds in this three-day workshop.

Participants will learn how to create interesting surfaces on slab built forms; how to mix and pour plaster; and how to carve designs using a variety of tools and use in the design and construction of a slab box. **Skill Level:** Beginner to Intermediate. Supplies will be provided. **Registration fee:** \$45; **Registration deadline:** Tuesday, February 19.



## Itajime Shibori and Indigo (How to Stitch Resist Your Cotton Kitchen Towel) (Instruction by Caroline Harper)

Saturday, March 9 2019 from 10 am-12 pm

Shibori is a very ancient Japanese art form dating back to the 8th century. Shibori is a Japanese manual resist dyeing technique, which produces patterns on fabric.

The technique that will be taught is called Itajime (triangle or rectangle fold) and a stitch resist created with strong Japanese cotton thread. During the class, you will learn how to prepare a non-fermented indigo vat and how to properly dye your kitchen towel.

Class size limited to minimum of 4 and maximum of 12 participants. **Registration fee:** \$50 (includes all supplies, materials and operating costs.)
