



# Beginning Quilting Class

## – Instruction by Anita Bowen\*

The participant will learn the basic rules, skills and techniques of patchwork and quilt making during these classes. Building on information learned in each session, participants will be able to create a lap size quilt using skills and techniques presented. This is geared towards the beginning quilter, but others wishing to refresh their skills are welcome.

- Session 1: Introduction to tools, rules and skills; Create a Nine Patch Block
- Session 2: Churn Dash Block; Jacob's Ladder and Star Flower
- Session 3: Dutchman's Puzzle, Card Tricks Blocks; Ohio Star Blocks
- Session 4: Sashing, borders, quilting and binding

Rotary cutter (45 mm)  
Rulers: 6 1/2" square and 6 1/2" x 24"  
Scissors for cutting fabric  
Seam Ripper  
Pins, needles  
Thread – light gray or beige  
Assorted 100% cotton – purchase after first class
